

EMAIL NOTIFICATION SET-UP

In order to utilise the e-mail alerts on the iApollo and Zeus DVR/NVR, Please follow the steps below.

1. Network your DVR/NVR as per page 1 of the networking guide found [here](#)
2. In the “network” section of the settings menu, locate the “DNS” field (not to be confused with DDNS)
3. From here you must enter the **Preferred** and **Alternative** DNS; these are available from your ISP. You can alternatively use OpenDNS, a free public DNS service. The addresses are as follows.
 - Preferred DNS: 208.67.222.222
 - Alternative DNS: 208.67.220.220

Note: DNS server addresses are required to resolve the mail server’s ip address. Without these, the mail feature may not work.



4. Enable EMAIL as above, then double click the word “EMAIL” to enter the E-Mail settings window.
5. You will see the window below, from here enter your mail server settings.



- **SMTP Server:** get this from your ISP. Eircom’s is **mail1.eircom.net**.
 - for a list of Irish SMTP servers, click [here](#)
- **Port:** The default SMTP port is **25**. Change if required.
- **Anonymous:** check this box if your mail server **doesn’t** require authentication.
- **Username/Password:** These fields are only required if your mail server **does** require authentication.
- **Receiver:** The E-Mail Address to receive the E-Mail Alerts.
- **Sender:** The Address that the E-Mail will be “From”. – Only required if Anonymous is **NOT** selected.
- **Title:** The “subject” of the E-Mail.
- **Attachment:** Check this box to allow snapshots to be e-mailed on motion/alarm.
 - Note: you must enable “e-mail” and “snapshot” in the alarm or detect settings
- **SSL Enable:** Use if your server requires SSL encryption.
- **Event Interval:** Set how frequently e-mails are sent per event.
- **HealthEnable:** With this enabled, you will receive an e-mail every hour to inform you that the DVR is online and still has internet access.
- **Interval:** Sets how frequently the “Health” e-mail is sent. The default is 60mins.
